Who Can Join an Adventurer Club?

Leadership

Adventurer leaders are vibrant Christians living the values that Jesus taught. By their teaching and example they show what it means to be a living, vibrant Christian in today's world.

Adventure leaders recognize that parents are the key relational ministers, who more than anyone else can create the sense of trust, love and concern vital to the development of a child's faith. They support parents in the important role by including them in club activities and by offering the Adventure Family Network.

The Adventure Staff Training Course has been set up to equip directors, associate directors and counselors for their leadership role in the club. This course of study helps them understand the program, the needs of the children and their parents and how to meet the objectives of the Adventurer program.

Organizational Structure

The goal of Adventurer clubs is to strengthen the parent-child relationship and to further the child's spiritual, physical, mental and social development.

The children progress through four class levels: Busy Bee, sunbeam, Builder, and Helping Hand, under the guidance of counselors and parents. All classes participate in club activities and meet for class work once a week on Fridays from 7:00-8:00 PM (a fellowship meal is provided from 6:30-7:00). Adventurer leaders and children have a dress uniform which includes scarves, insignias and awards; they wear T-shirts for informal activities.

The Adventurer Family Network is part of the Adventurer Club designed specifically for the Adventurer parents or other caregivers. Training

Adventure Clubs provide a curriculum with four levels of learning: Busy Bee, Sunbeam, Builder, and Helping Hand. Each level includes four tracks emphasizing: My God, Myself, My Family, and My World.

Leaders provide instruction in areas of Christian values, health and fitness, arts and crafts, nature, and people skills. Adventurers receive a certificate and "Adventure Class Pin" upon completion of each course of study.
